- **8.3** Annette Gray of Suffolk Acre attended the meeting to give a presentation on Parish Plans which are designed to allow local people to identify issues which they consider important to their community, and, with the introduction of the Localism Bill, can be used to influence policies adopted by both district and county councils. The form of plan adopted can vary, dependant on the size of the parish. Larger parishes might have the resources to undertake a parish plan, but smaller parishes, such as Thorndon, might consider a village review. This will identify high priority issues concerning the community, generally about 4-8 in number. Suffolk Acre is available to facilitate the undertaking, at the cost, for a village review, of £525 + VAT.
