05.07.12 – 02 Cllr Bartlett has confirmed that the order for the signs has been placed but, currently, there is no specific date for installation. Picking up on an observation made at the last meeting, Cllr Bartlett confirmed that the speed-activated illuminating sign on the A140 is no longer working as the photo-electric cells powering the same have been removed. Replacement parts are no longer available and the Highways Department at Suffolk County Council are to reassess the site to ascertain whether a replacement sign is justified in the light of the current criteria applicable to such installations which are expensive. If it is decided that a replacement speed-activated illuminating sign is not justified a metal 'Slow Down' sign could be considered. Cllr Ravenhill will speak to the Chairman of Stoke Ash Parish Council to ascertain whether they are pursuing this matter as this junction with the A140 is an accident black spot. **Action Point 06.09.12-01**
