- **05.07.12 01** Cllr Bartlett has spoken with Colonel Lee about the visibility of affordable housing being built in the Village. Whilst there is a current planning consent for the erection of 6 affordable houses on the Kerrison site it is not economically viable to develop the same at the moment, albeit the planning permission will be renewed when necessary.

Cllr Ravenhill suggested a joint meeting of representatives from both Parish Councils with Suffolk County Council to see if the matter could be addressed. - 7.3 The Clerk advised that the current arrangement for paying in cheques to the Bank of Ireland by post was erratic, with half of the cheques sent being lost. The Bank had, therefore, provided an application form for completion which would allow cheques to be paid in at a Post Office. This issue raised the general question as to whether the Parish Council was still receiving a better rate of interest from the Bank of Ireland, which is why the account was originally opened. It was confirmed that there was no financial advantage to remaining with the Bank of Ireland, and in all the circumstances it would be preferable to close the account and move everything to Barclays Bank plc. **Action point 01.11.12 01**
- 7.4 The grass cutting contract has now expired, and informal discussions have taken place with Robert Fieblekorn who has confirmed that he is content to provide a quotation for a new 3 year contract but indicated he might vary the basis of payment whereby his costs are calculated on the number of cuts. The Clerk will write to Robert Fieblekorn inviting his tender for the contract. Action point 01.11.12 02
- **7.5** This issue of bi-monthly meetings was reviewed following the 6 month trial. Overall it was felt that the Parish Council was losing momentum with the bi-monthly arrangement and that it was preferable to revert to monthly meetings, excluding August.

7.6 The Parish Council will need to set its precept for 2013/14 before the end of January. Cllr Faulkner is to be asked if he will meet with the Clerk to review the Parish Council's income and expenditure before discussing the precept at January's Parish Council meeting. If Cllr Faulkner cannot do this, Cllr Le Gros will undertake the task.

- **8.1** The Parish Council has received a letter from a resident of Fen View expressing concern about another house, and the fact that the occupant would appear to have vacated the same. Cllr Ravenhill will speak to Andrew Weaver at Mid Suffolk District Council about the issues raised. **Action point 01.11.12 03**
- **8.2** It was felt that the Parish Council should revisit the results of the Village Questionnaire to confirm that all matters identified have been properly addressed.
- **8.3** Cllr Taylor, in his capacity as Footpath Monitor confirmed that in the absence of any 'Welcome Pack' from Mid Suffolk District Council, he has requested copies of the definitive maps of footpaths around the Village and hopes to develop a positive relationship between walkers and landowners in the coming months.
- **8.4** Mr Brand delivered his report on behalf of neighbourhood watch.
