03.10.14 – 03 Cllr Hayward confirmed that the Community Council is currently looking into the possibility of providing a generator at the Village Hall, and will be approaching the Church for a contribution towards this. To date Cllr Hayward has been unsuccessful in his attempts to contact Rev J Lall and whilst it is felt unlikely that the Church will be in a position to make a contribution they should be given the opportunity so to do. In the alternative, the

project will progress and it is suggested that the Parish Council and Community Council will fund the acquisition.

06.11.14 – 01 John Simpson has finally emailed the response of the Highways Department to Thorndon's Vehicle Activated Sign ('VAS') application. The response, which was circulated to Councillors ahead of the meeting, has approved sites for the installation of a VAS in locations which differ to those identified by the traffic data gathered in support of the application. Councillors were unhappy with the recommendations and Cty Cllr Stringer will invite John Simpson to an on-site meeting in order that the concerns of the Parish Council can be discussed. **Action Point 12.11.15 - 01**

04.12.14 - 01 &

- **01.10 15 01** The timetable for the broadband upgrade is still awaited. Following October's meeting Cllr Farquhar did invite Mr Peter Ingram, Programme Director of the Suffolk Better Broadband Programme to meet with the Parish to host a 'Question and Answer' session. Mr Ingram in his response advised that the remodelled version of coverage under the second contract with BT is not due until end of October, and given the immense interest in the revised rollout timeline, Suffolk Better Broadband Programme is planning series of roadshows across the county in early 2016. Cty Cllr Stringer said that the roll out programme publication had been promised for this week and as soon as he had any information he would send it to the Clerk for circulation.
- **02.07.15 01** Cllr Ravenhill confirmed that some progress has been made, although there is not yet a definite agreement, it has been confirmed verbally that a replacement card telephone will be installed.
- **02.07.15 04** Cllr Ravenhill advised that the correct route for such a working group is the SALC North Area meeting. The Clerk will confirm the date of the next meeting to Cllr Ravenhill.
- **03.09.15 03** The Clerk confirmed that she has now received a response from Highways at Suffolk County Council on the issue of flooding at the junction north of Brockford Garage with the A140. Highways confirmed that drainage contractors have cleaned out a kerb offlet north of Brockford Garage which should prevent the build-up of surface water at the junction. They will continue to monitor surface water collection at the double bends before the bridge leading to this junction, as when the area was inspected, much of the surface water had drained away.
- **03.09.15 04** The Clerk confirmed that she has not received a reply on this. However, she has received notification of a consultation by the Suffolk Roadsafe Partnership who is to undertake an analysis of collisions across the county in order to identify where collisions occur and road users may be at a higher risk than expected. The A140 has been identified as one such area and consultants Aecom are currently undertaking a study of the collision patterns, causation factors and a range of recommendations that could be implemented from the A143 to the A1120. There is no need for any feedback whilst the study is being undertaken. Once the recommendations have been received and reviewed stakeholders, which includes the Parish Council, will be asked for their views of the recommendations for this location.

6.1 Planning Applications: None.

- Cllr Ravenhill attended the recent Parish Liaison Meeting at Mid Suffolk District Council at which it is quite clear Neighbourhood Plans are being promoted. It is essential that Thorndon acts to ensure its views on planning applications and other planning issues are taken into consideration by the planning department. Whilst the Parish Council will not be able to prevent future development, with a Neighbourhood Plan, it should be able to steer where such development is sited. Cllr Ravenhill has spoken to Sarah Payne who is currently assisting Wetheringsett with the preparation of their Neighbourhood Plan. She suggested that if Thorndon were interested in preparing a Neighbourhood Plan, then if it works together with Wetheringsett, costs could be reduced. Cllr Ravenhill will now speak to the Chairman of Wetheringsett Parish Council, Richard Anscombe on this. Action Point 12.11.15 02
- District Cllr Horn said he would clarify whether the Functional Clusters had now been finalised and confirm whether the same have any relevance to planning policies and the Community Infrastructure Levy.
