REPORT FOR THORNDON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING - 05/01/2012.

Reported Crimes.

There has been one reported crime in the Parish of Thorndon since our last report.

During the night of 12/13th December there was an attempted theft from a motor vehicle parked at premises in Thwaite Road, nothing was taken although the vehicle was damaged.

Security for Winter.

We are now at the darkest time of the year so please continue to be vigilant regarding the security of your premises. Garages, Sheds and workshops are extremely vulnerable. Where possible install security lighting and fit secure locks to protect mowers, bicycles, tools and electrical equipment.

Oil tanks continue to be targeted by thieves, again please ensure you fit adequate means to protect your investment, including screening, lighting and padlock alarms.

Vehicles should be secured in garages or parked in open well-lit areas please do not leave valuables on view, either in a vehicle or your home.

Take pictures of valuable items and record their identification numbers or register them on the National database "Immobilise." If you have valuable mobile equipment consider having tracking devise fitted

New Non Emergency telephone number.

For the benefit of anyone who has not seen our communications regarding contact numbers for **non emergencies**, this is **101** which should be used when a Police Officer is required but not as a matter of Urgency. .ie. minor damage without witnesses.

In the case of a Real EMERGENCY always dial 999.
