### **Reported Crimes.**

There has been one crimes reported in the Parish of Thorndon since our last report.  
An attempted theft of a trailer in Clint road

### **Security for Winter.**

We are seeing an increase in thefts of catalytic converters mainly from 4 x 4 and large vans please try to ensure vehicles are left secure and consider fitting a cat lock or marking the catalytic converter.  
We have also had a number of number plate thefts the plates being used to disguise vehicles for use in crime and in avoiding charges if you are replacing number plates please use security plates which shatter when removed making them useless to the thief the security plates are marked and are usually not targeted

There is an increase in thefts of laptop computers from schools we are advising all laptop devices are locked away securely when not in use

### **Oil Thefts.**
