REPORT FOR THORNDON ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING – 01/05/2014.

Reported Crimes

From 2012-2013 there were 10 crimes reported to us in the Parish of Thorndon:

- 4 Burglaries of other buildings – these are not homes but buildings such as sheds
- 1 case of Criminal Damage
- 4 Thefts including 1 from a motor-vehicle
- 1 case of Arson

Unfortunately the figures show that Thorndon have been the victim of more crimes in 2013-2014:

- 5 cases of Criminal Damage.
- 6 Burglaries – 5 of other buildings such as sheds and one of a dwelling such as a house.
- 4 cases of Theft – 3 being CAT converters stolen from motor-vehicles. These offences were committed during a spate of CAT converter thefts at the time and the SNT are holding Cat marking events to combat such crime. The next one taking place on Saturday 17th May at Evergreen garage in Crowfield.

GENERAL

We have had some good results with burglaries in the area east of the A140 recently closing off a spate of burglaries reported in June and July time of last year. We've managed to apprehend 2 separate groups of offenders and detect several burglaries in the area.

One of these was fairly unique in that the offender was not known in this country and we identified him via a DNA hit in Lithuania resulting in an arrest when his feet hit the tarmac at the airport a few weeks ago.

Take pictures of valuable items and record their identification numbers or register them on the National database "Immobilise." If you have valuable mobile equipment consider having tracking device fitted.
